# CANADA: YOUR MOST IMPORTANT TRADE AND INVESTMENT PARTNER

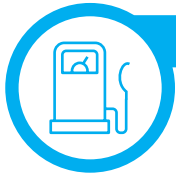
Annual value of goods & services exports to Canada from West Virginia's 3rd Congressional District:

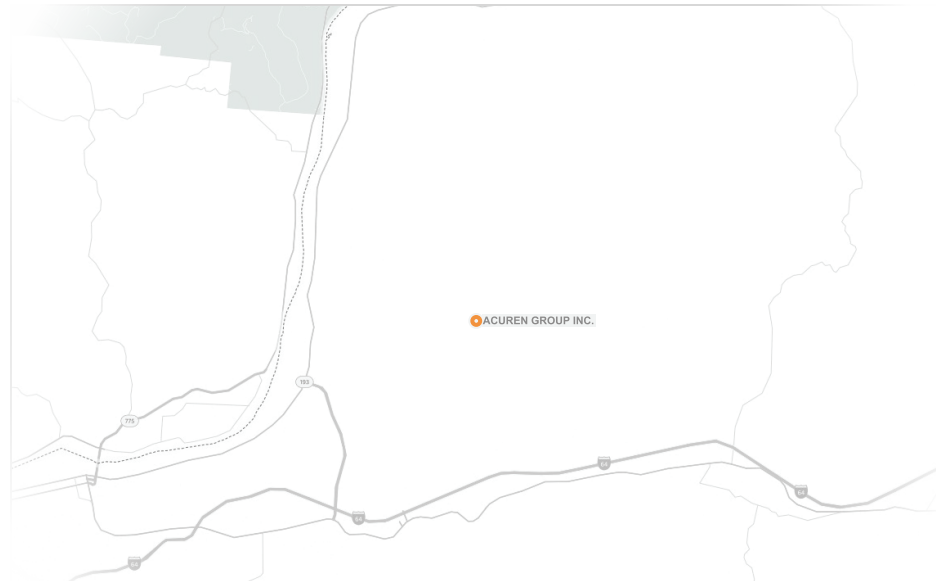

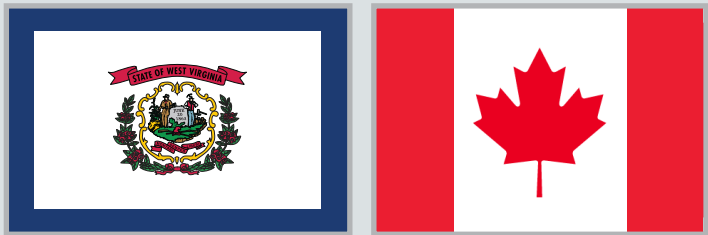
