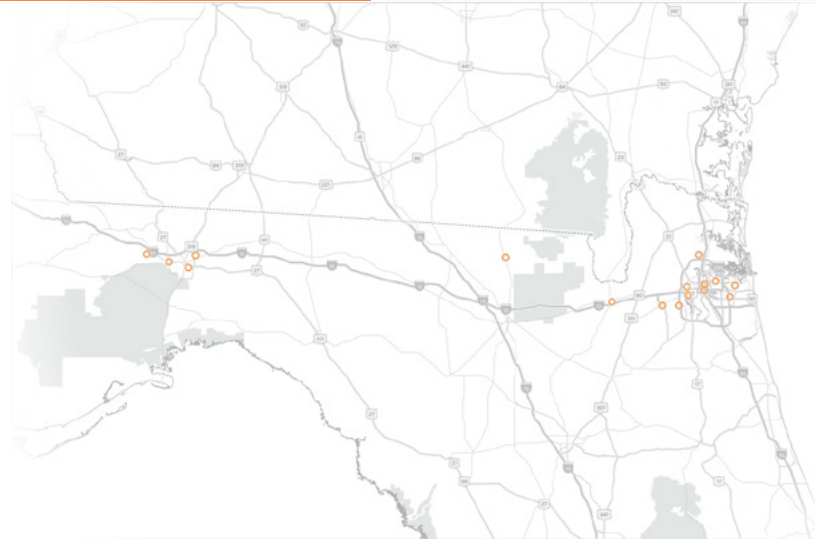
Annual value of goods & services exports to Canada from Florida's 5th Congressional District:

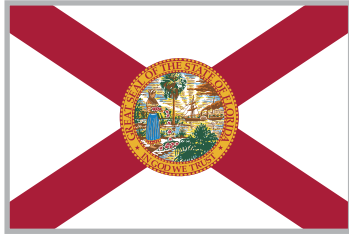

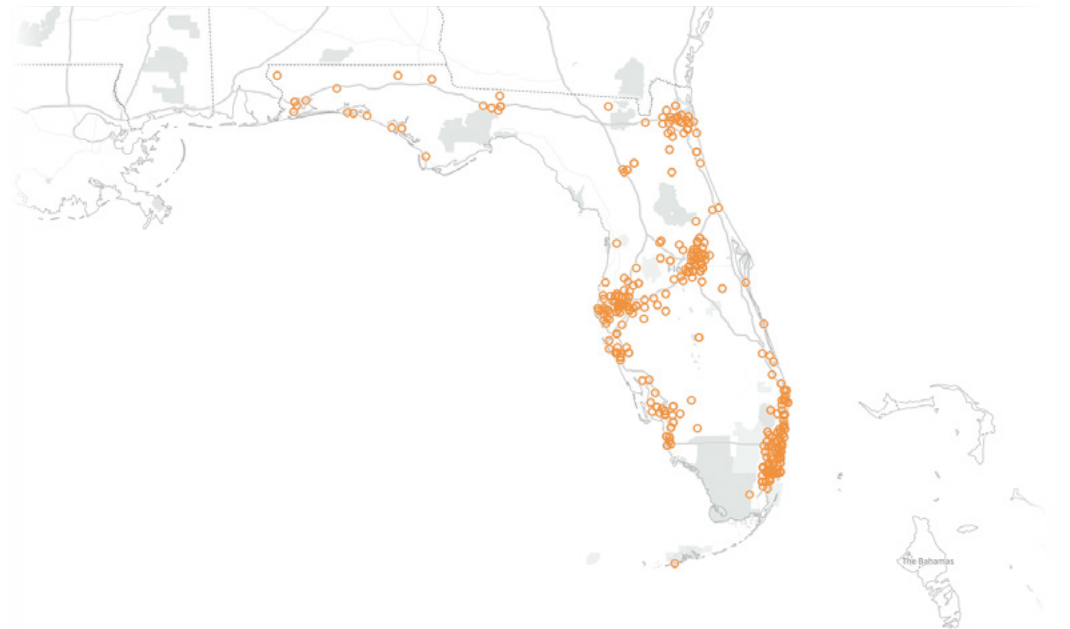
