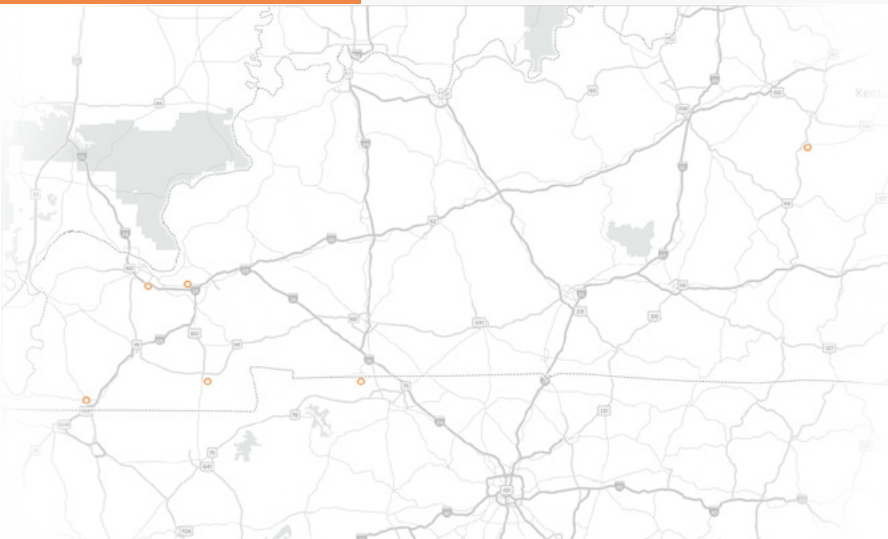
CANADA: YOUR MOST IMPORTANT TRADE AND INVESTMENT PARTNER

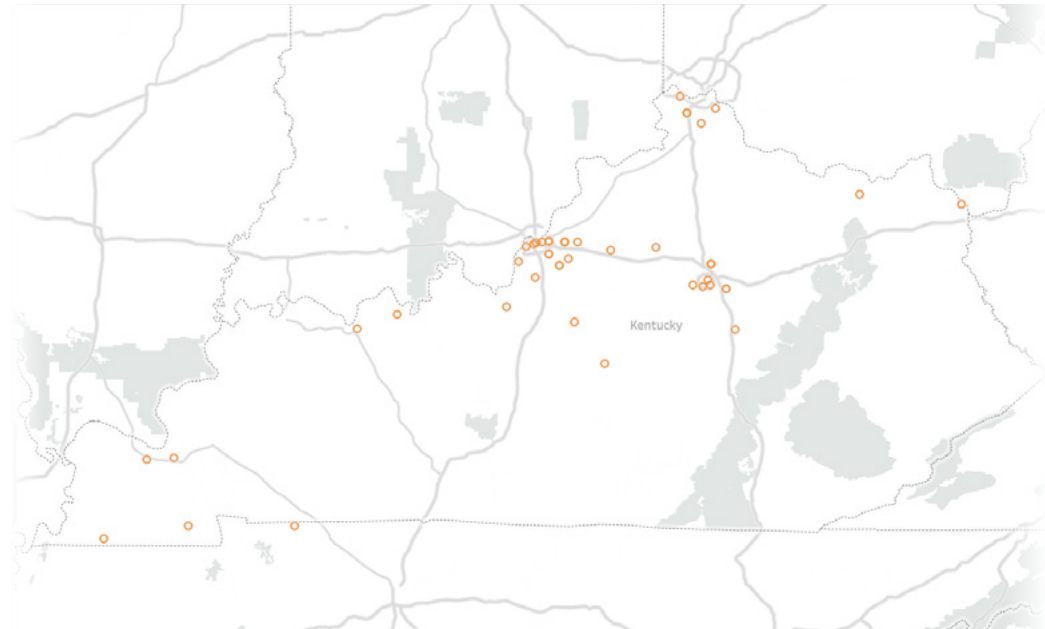
