Annual value of goods & services exports to Canada from West Virginia's 2nd Congressional District:

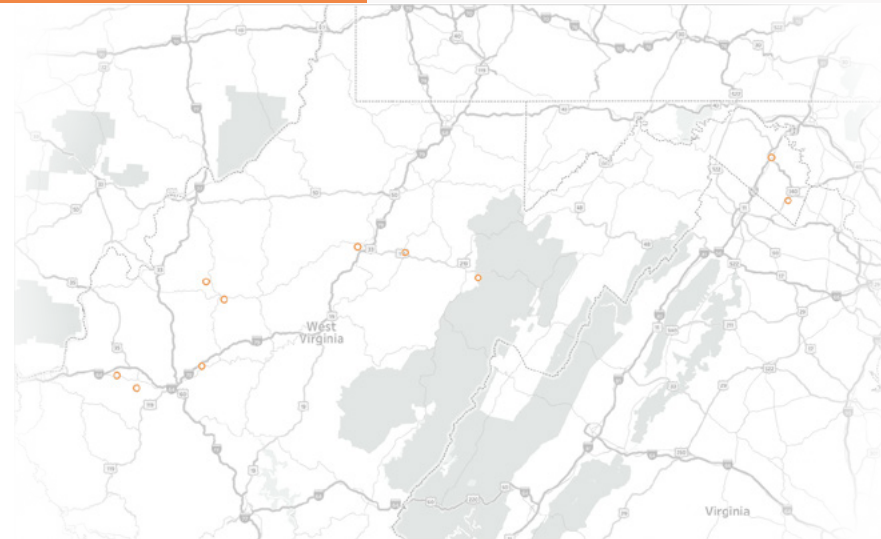

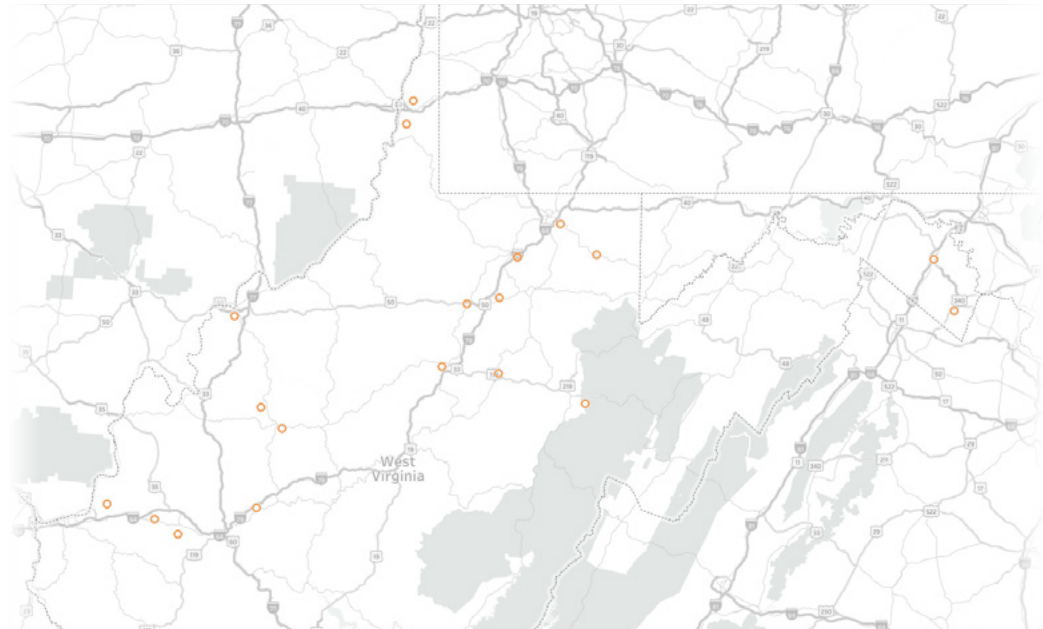
